If your flight arrives in Helsinki, you can continue by train to Kannus or Ylivieska train station. Kannus railway station is closer to the destination, but not all trains stop there. You can check it with VR:s schedule search. There is not much public transportation in these regions, so a taxi or other agreed transportation is the only
